look at the Score 18th Began to make
a new house and took a Bad pain in my
Back its the Backache i can hardly stir
with it Fed the Horses some Oats peeling
and salt they have not the disorder
other horses has put the Hens in their
house to night the calves stopt away
to night snowing to night Windy
