Thu Mar 27th clear and pleasant. I was gatreing the little sap that run and trimming some of the apple trees. John was repairing fence

Fri Mar 28th cloudy and cool. not doing much to day. James Camron was here and was visiting with him most of the day.

Sat Mar 29th cloudy high wind from the North and cold not doing much to day. Anne appears a little better but wheather it will last I can't say.

Sun Mar 30th ~~cloud~~ clear most of the day and cold.

Mon Mar 31st cloudy and cool. I took a load of oats to Dresden and got chopt. Anne not so well.

Tue ~~Apr~~ Apr 1st cloudy and rain most of the day. I was boiling in Sap Sugar of about 20 lbs of sugar today.

Wed Apr 2nd cloudy high and cold. was boiling in the Sap and gatched yesterday.

Thu Apr 3rd clear high wind and cool. was boiling Sap most of the day.

Fri Apr 4th clear high wind from the North the last two days and cool. Sap running well. I went up to Florence for medicine for Anne. She is no better.

Sat Apr 5th clear and pleasant. I and Walter was sawing stove wood. Anne no better.

Sun Apr 6th clear and pleasant

Mon Apr 7th clear most of the day. the Sap run well yesterday and to day. I was boiling Sap. John commenced to plough the ground rather wet.

Tue Apr 8th clear part of the day moderate. I was boiling in Sap. John was plowing. Mr Smith took Walter up to the Dr. and got his tooth drawn. Anne about the same.

Wed Apr 9th cloudy and cool. John was plowing. I was repairing fence. Some snow last night.

Thu Apr 10th cloudy and cool. repairing fence John was plowing.

Fri Apr 11th clear and pleasant. I was repairing fence and boiling in Sap. John was plowing.

Sat Apr 12th clear and pleasant. went to mill and got some oats and corn chopt.

Sun Apr 13th clear a fine day. the Dr and his brother down to see Anne. She his no better.

Mon Apr 14th clear part of the day high wind from the South East and warm. I was boiling a little Sap that run yesterday and day before. and burning brush heaps over by the old man Brownless. John was plowing. Anne had a very bad night last night and poorly to day.
