Mr. Tammes Cameron Island Dec 14
 Sunday some cold no snow on the ground & wind
 a good many Ducks this morning shot over
 Well 15th Went to the Bush for the slush
 took home 3 Drives Drew the Fish Box to the Barn
 for to put Hayseed Thats on the Barn floor in it
 cleaned up the Barn for Windy Stormy snowing
 cutting stone Wood 16th moving the Hay from the
 West Mow to the East mow so to get at the Wheat
 Some cold turned fine in the Evening frosty to night
 17th some snow North West Wind Hazing cold Wind to
 night began the Wheat to thresh threshed 3 hours
 got the clock to start it shot about 2 Weeks
 making Bismarck a comforter 18th very cold Wind
 threshing 19th threshing very cold East Wind got kind of
 soft through the night 20th snowing West Wind
 some cold first sun in a the month this morning
 finished the threshing put it in 2 Boxes till I
 can get it hauled a good deal of ice in the
 Bay and out to the edge of the Lakes Water
 cold Windy to night and all the time 21st
 Sunday the Water all in a thin ice freeze
 hard and calm till near night when the
 East Wind and snow and drifts began to
 an awful night 22nd stormy till near
 night the ice taken aeroft last night grew
 snowbanks and drifts the Potatoes and
 grass were in the cellar 23rd some cold
 I went to try the ice I scraped but it
 never thin went to town town bought
 of Mr. Ward 2 lb Tea 20 Soap 10 Bought of
 Summers matches and fire 3 cents had a
 letter from Dan a Happy New Years car
 breaking the Roads Ward Butter was
 took I Hamiltons Morte house from the
 Roads as it is lame Mrs. Hamilton sent
 rice of cheese to Lorraine and apples to the
 children

Mr. Tammes Cameron Island Dec 24th
 soft raining and hailing East Wind feeding the cattle
 extra as by Christmas Eve and cold weather cutting
 wood 25 Christmas Day fine but cold West Wind
 changed at night keeping to day as it should be kept
 in Hoby Day 26th cold east Wind I cropped sheep 11
 Hamiltons then went to Mr. Ward Cotton Credit 100th
 of flour 3.50 Bought 2 lbs Soda Drawing needle 1
 lota hole down with Tom Jack a very frosty Day
 Bill all worn crooked with a horse & record to
 Bay left my Hauld Hamilton till tomorrow go to
 my brother after it 27th stormy this morning turned fine
 Randolph and I crossed to Hamiltons for
 the Flax put out some bushes for our
 road Tom Jack went to gather ashes to
 East Wind snow sun & draws water 28
 roads crooked the ice to Hopkins I dont know
 what it was 28th Sunday a very fine Day East Wind
 and an Eclipse on the Moon and a change in the
 Moon Full Moon to Day a great many fishing
 boats over 7pm the Spanish Island a good
 many ice holes Bill a great many shut
 with the stormy night of the 21st 25th our Angus
 Park Dog set 4 traps in the bushes a fine soft Day
 cut some holes for 3 lbs 30th cold chipping stone wood 31st
 cold and stormy East Wind last Day off the air 1st January
 1876 JAN 1 1876 a very fine Day Break kind
 boards drew some wood W Wind shot a bird Pickel not
 enough shooting 2nd soft W Wind Randolph and I hit the
 ice a bushing the road from Mr. Pheas to Lancaster
 drew some wood I brok a road up in the swamp seen where
 fore eat a bluesay 3rd 1876 Birth Day cold
 Wind frosty cutting brush up in cord wood Bay a good
 deal of cropping summer to road to night commened to sail
 running fore beginning to night of Sunday raining foggy slippery
 ice W Wind of Ordin Cane 4th Mr. Hamilton seen
 fore cropping here cropped the sugar Bush Water on
 the ice
