A slight frost last night. Fine sunny day warmer to-day it has been very cool since N.S. up all day driving loads tiles from station with Magwood also hauling with his team we got 12 loads up to-day Willie and Bill Nelson loading at car. I deepened ditch between loads, the ditchers got drain starting at our drain through brush near creek. run parallel with creek turned up along lane up through to turnips No 6. Mary walked down PM got at Shooters meat \$1.40 groceries 7 to 8.70cts bread 7 to 8.29cts

440 Fine day warm sunny and cloudy N.S. up all day helping with tiles and turning manure. We finished the unloading car this AM with Magwood hauled 2 loads 8m and Nelson one 4m Willie brought last load tiles and 3 tanks gasoline for Marshall paid freight on them \$1.16 paid Bill Nelson \$2.25. I deepened ditch to outlet of 6 in tile drain also deepened it some to get tiles below the Ford drain. The drainers got long ditch finished up to hollow in hay field No 7 got some of another nest wire fence at bush No 6 running parallel with long one.
