- 4 Rained most all of the night. Day is fine, high wind & bright sun. But 3 yds black print 30 30
2 yds red cotton 20. 1 pan bread 25, gave 57 to 95-
- Munday Aug 25 - 23 split up for board 25-
- 5 Went to the S.P. picnic we took the double wagon. had a pleasant time
- 6 The travelling dairy was at Mrs. Ross's I was there to see
There was a Will Johnson drowned in the village today fell out of a boat above Burro's blacksmith shop
2 loaves 15, gave Jim & Ran each 25 for 40
the picnic for the two.
Murdy got me 15.75 at L.S.P.
- 7 Went to Lancaster with Far. Bot at the Crummins 2 black calico dresses 1.68 1.68
4 yds white lawn 1.24. 8 yds brown calico 80
