- 1 Tuesday, rained all day. Pa and boys mixing mortar in the cellar for furnace
- 2 Muddy took R. K. & A. to John Tamm's. Allick Santinore moved into old post office. Allick Pitchardson moved into Rentail Row. Bought 100 of flour from Dunlop 3⁰⁰ * 3
span bread 25^{cts} 25 -
- 3 Rain, snow & hail all day. Womens Meeting at the Manse 2 members present 14 with the ladies of the house my offering 10^{cts} gave Muddy 100 to send to Toronto 1
got 1 loaf bread 7^{cts} I baked in oven
- 4 Jimmie went to Lancaster and got the furnace rained all the afternoon expect the men tomorrow to set the furnace
- 5 Rain again all day the men came but did not do any thing Kate came
- 6 Rained all day I did not go to church. There was no prayer meeting
- 7 Wet again. Got a ham at J. S. Saturday night 1.35 = Got fore qr of Lamb today 65. Apples 20 = molasses 15 + pepper 5^{cts} Men came and began 1 35
- 8 Rain & snow. Got beef 56^{cts} sugar 20 76
paid Francis Brauser 1.50. for one days work at furnace. John M. Gill, Tanner, took Annie & Kate away
- 9 Beautiful day. I washed but did not hang out. 9 P. M. There was a very heavy snow about 7.50. Just as we went to prayer meeting, we taking up potatoes poor crop
- 10 Friday Evening I am going to Harroys foot
- 11 I spent a pleasant evening at Harroys with Miss Hall. The boys finished one field of potatoes. The black boys took care here
