Willie took 500 lbs pig chop to mill 9 AM 30cts brought up 520 lbs white dust 100 lbs barley dust ^{\$2.50 by charge} P.M. he hauled load gravel from Bretts to 7 L for road work then brought up chop. I fixed lame fence 9 AM cultivated corn P.M. Willie and the girls drove down town at night took 12 day eggs to Russells @ 25cts on afc Wm Clark afc P.M. got 2 day eggs 46 5 Willie and girls went over to cemetery.
