 Fishing at Christie's caught 1 Pickerel that weighed $8\frac{3}{4}$ lb
 very smoky time with fog the St Francis ahead
 going up to day bay court to day took our dinner
 on Christie's Island found a Tackle Knife in the Water
 31st Went across to John Kessington found a large
 square of Tobacco on the shore working at their store
 went to the store Bought some Smithfield salt soap
 got my Reporter went to Mr Kershaw's took
 3 Papers down for Mr Tyler Lincoln to the
 Lighthouse came down on the North side of our
 Island and found Randolph's knife he lost
 in the water the St Francis ahead going there
 going down this morning Charlie Parsha working
 at the Bridge 1st of Oct 1st 1876
 Drawing Wood making a heap of Loops from the River
 filled 5 Bags with ash 2nd a fine day but Windy
 Rained hard last night blowed some in the morning
 But the Water is high I must quit it Lots of
 shooting an Indian Big Mitchell's son looking for
 a canoe he lost he was here yesterday evening cool
 3rd of Oct Mr McAllister's Birth Day Sunday
 very Windy cool and fine Corinthian went down
 the Wind breaking the Tobacco leaves took home
 some hazel nuts from the Kitt Point 4th Drawing
 Wood 5th John Angus Birth Day went to the
 Kit Kit Gordon and Windy stop all day 6th
 crossed Left Gordon at Hamilton got a Bag
 of Apples Bought of Vespers 4 Loaves of Bread
 matches John Kessington unwell drew some
 hay 7th drew in some hay sowed hay seed in
 the Oakfield 8th Drawing Wood 9th Windy
 10th Went to Hamilton John and Tom Gordon
 Alex's Island shooting Deer now 11th crossed
 with 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ of Ashes Bought of Sandfield 2 lb of
 Bought of Vespers 2 lb Powder 15 cents matches

 Fishing some 13th Putting out manure 14th Handing
 and Fishing 15th Drawing Wood Ranald Angus
 Departed 16th crossed got 150 from Mr Kessington
 Bought of Vespers 2 lb Tea matches fare
 A J Baker my Bag to bring me 100 lb of
 Flour from Montreal West Wind high Henry
 Gene and his Boy came took Gordon from Hamilton got
 Potatoes near done 17th Windy Henry went to Charlie
 Island Ellen hunting there 18th Wind Windy Fishing
 19th Henry Gordon and I crossed Left Gordon at
 Hamilton Bought of Sandfield 5 lb of Flour 150
 got 25 cents from Henry 1 lb shot some caps
 Henry Bought 12 Quarts of Shot 1 Box of Caps
 Fishing chub set the Rope line 20th Splitting
 Paul Henry crossed to Mr Donalds Below
 Frasers fourth side Henry came back to
 night 21st of Oct Matthew last Day of Summer
 Henry went off to meet the Boat at the
 Drawing Wood 22nd Autumn or Fall Begin
 Drawing Wood 23rd Drawing Wood and crossed to
 Kershaw's for 100th of Flour I got from A J Baker
 took up on the Bohemian from Montreal
 the Victoria Steamer moved to Kershaw's Wharf
 pumped her this week and found 2 Acour holes
 in her where some villain did on the intention
 of getting a job of Puling her 24th Windy 25th
 of Charlie Ross came to mow the Marsh
 I went with Gordon to Kessington's got the
 Hops and the Apples on the Tree in
 the Potatoes got some Tin Dishes in the
 Rush at Hamilton's East Wind this
 10 Days seen James gave Charlie some 2 lb of
 26th Rainy Mr Fulton Do Primo James Barnes came
 took in the Double Store a Wet Duty Day Mr Fulton
 caught 3 chub and 13 perch 1 Dove Brought me
 2 lb Powder 1 Box of Cap 2 lb of Shot
