Rained last night and pretty steady all day
a tremendous amount of rain fell everything
flooded. Willie took 1370 lbs pig chop to Wilcox
& 8 cts got Bony dust 3.00 Jess shod Borty 50 cts
first shoes, trip rope gall care and mending W. Gernott
\$1.15 sugar at Armstrongs 2 cts 4.00. We did
inside work to-day put ladder of centre ~~at~~ end posts
in barn. J. Crabbe & Schainin in at night. till about the sea pigs.

More rain last night cloudy and sunny to-day. Willie
at Crabbs till 2 o'clock at gravel banking he to their home. I shingled
some more of the barn. Turned over hay side deling rake etc. Mr. Gass over
in morning splicing rope. Willie down town at night got at Mearns
oil 5 cts. Willie had Dan and Kate at Crabbs.
