- June 5th Geo. Millers came over to spend Sunday with us.
- " 7th Started to plant potatoes, plowing down a crop of sweet clover.
- " 9th Went to North Brant S.S. Convention at Cairsville in the afternoon.
Edith and the children going to Eva McCreas and I to G. Allens for
dinner, Jennie Stewart came out and helped Cyril with the milking.
- " 10th Finished planting potatoes nearly 2 acres. 3 1/2 rows of D. Cobble
on West side & row of Dakota Red and 1 1/2 row of Roundbark seed.
The balance in Green Mountains.
- " 11th John Mc Knight ^{came} called for a little while and Will Breen and
family of Ingersoll came for a little visit. a heavy rain after dinner.
- " 12th Mrs. Mrs. D. Wilson of Paris came over for a little visit.
- " 13th Finished drawing manure to turnip ground.
- " 14th Finished plowing turnip ground, Miss Preston the Women's
Institute delegate stayed with us over night.
