- Sept 1 cut the wheat in the middle field in the forenoon - 10 a  
Billie drew 3 loads of sand for the church then <sup>me</sup> & Billie cut  
the oats at Sheapards pineday
- 2 drew in the oats below the house fine crop
- 3 drew in the wheat from the middle field & the peas &  
oats below the house in the forenoon & the oats at  
Sheapards in the afternoon hard work fine weather
- 4 cut wheat at Sheapards & drew in some of the  
wheat the scatch wheat that was mixed with the  
midge crop was all taken up with the midge
- 5 the Revd Mr Smart preached in the schoolhouse in the  
afternoon & Revd Mr Falloock in the forenoon
- 6 the Boys finished the cutting of the wheat at Sheapards  
I went with Mr Thompson to Mr Thompson's & got out 4 sets  
for the church & drew them home
- 7 a little rain this morning I went with S. Ballmer & saw  
his wife sign a deed of her place in Granby t. S. Sheep-  
ards & Billie helped Eb Young to cut wheat in the afternoon  
on Tues & drew 3 loads of sand for the church
- 8 rain most of the day nothing done
- 9 Billie & Gordy went to town & went to the schoolhouse
- 10 Billie & Gordy drew 3 loads of clay to the <sup>Bratt</sup> - field. We went to Hallow town to the stone
- 11 worked at the peas they are a good crop
- 12 the Revd Mr Gordon preached in the forenoon in  
the schoolhouse Billie took him to Peasey
- 13 to Ellen & I went to the & soon went to Peasey  
this morning I worked in the sand pit for the  
church Mr Darlin Smith came to draw Billie  
& Gordy went to Hallow over peas
- 14 got James H. Miller's horse & drew in four loads  
of peas Thompson young helped Billie to draw
- in the wheat at Sheapards
- 15 finished drawing in the peas at home with Peasey  
horse & drew the remainder of the sets for the  
church Mr Thompson helped & the sets for it.
