Willie took 563 lbs cow chop down in
morning also lbs wool to Russell's at
14cts 16.44 (due bills) chop 28 sows to date 1.00
We got 24 more drills made and sowed turnips
New Century, Canadian Sun, got rest of No 2
almost plowed. Willie down town at night got
straw hat at Russell's \$1.25 (the 13cts). Mrs Mutch
paid us for oats \$2.40 hay \$7.10. Gave Dillon & man by potato
Willie brought up 120 shingle from J.F.H.
