Cloudy, thawing all day. We put casting in cedar cut wood etc. Mary down town in P.M., I went down at night to Mr M. Vicar's lecture on King Arthur and the Knights of the round table admittance 15 cts. as the lecture was about finished the jam came down the river and the electric lights went out. Wilson's barn was torn away with the rush of ice from Foxfield.

25

Saturday

Fine warm sunny spring day thawing a lot. We took to 7 1/2 load manure we left in snow drift on 23rd and in P.M. 2 more loads. Bella went down in P.M. Willie down at night. Featherbone 10 cts

26

Sunday

Fine in P.M. Raining in A.M. some Mr McVicar preached in A.M. from Heb 11:22. a sermon about Joseph. Home of us down at night.

27

Monday

Fine sunny warm day thawing a lot some wheels on road. no slipping in town for a week lot of snow on C.S.R. yet. Willie took 7 bags pig chop to Curless and brought it up again 35 1/2 paint in Merris H.O. Is pd in P.M. hauled back to T.S. 2 loads manure and brought over load calf hay. Mended cedar got at Sherwoods sale in evening.

Warm sunny thawing day. We cut wood etc cleaned wood shed, yard. started to make hot bed etc.
