Very Warm Corinthian went up to  
Dick and one of the men went to  
fish at Lancaster very warm Fine  
Leander crossed Heard Fraser & Howard  
Had a fight 13<sup>th</sup> Mowing 14<sup>th</sup> Warm Fine  
Mowing 15<sup>th</sup> Fine very warm putting on  
Hay Mowed some Rained to night  
Thunder and Lightning and Wind  
St Swithens Day Narcisse to Butter & Oil
