 Dandy 24 at home. W. Foggy & drizzly <sup>am. clear Pm</sup>  
 25 finished digging Potatoes till about 3 Pm they  
 are a very light crop on account of the dry weather  
 we got about 50 bus off an acre Aaron Plowed  
 & I brought home wagon from Cherry wood I got new  
 spokes & fellows into it W. fine warm clear  
 26 Plowed <sup>both</sup> AM set horse Power <sup>raining now after dark</sup> Pm. W. Cool. Windy  
 27 Threshed 24 1/2 bus barley & 14 1/2 bus Oats Machine  
 went very well W. rain last night & this morning  
 didn't start threshing until after 8 o'clock some  
 showers through the day, got done before 5 o'clock  
 This is my 40<sup>th</sup> Birth day  
 28 Both Plowed AM I & boys made 1 1/2 Cider Pm  
 29 Both Plowed. W. fine clear <sup>W. show Pm</sup>  
 30 I & boy made 1 1/2 lbs Cider AM Plowed Pm W. clear  
 Sunday Oct 1 at home John & Glawie went to Meeting  
 at Cedar Grove. W. Cool My Mother is still poor  
 2 I boiled Dance Aaron Plowed W. Clear  
 3 Both Plowed AM Chisel Pm I went to H  
 Store. W. Cloudy AM rain nearly all Pm  
 4 Both Plowed, Aaron began in barley stubble. I finished  
 behind barn then went in barley stubble. W. Cool, clear  
 5 I & Aaron Plowed AM he went to Menk town Pm  
 John & I Plowed Pm. W. Cool Clear bought new  
 Steel Clippa Plow off B. C. @ \$16.00 John  
 6 I & Nancy went to Whitevale AM Chisel <sup>clipped it well</sup> & Picked Cider  
 Apples Pm Aaron is at Fair W. rainy & cool  
 7 Aaron Plowed I & boys made 54 gals Cider AM  
 all Picked winter Apples Pm. W. Cool Cloudy

Monday 8 Children went to Meeting <sup>at 10</sup> at Hebron I & Nancy staid  
 with my Mother she is very low W. very Cold squalls of  
 dry sleet B. C. & J. H. Kumanis were here awhile Pm  
 9 I boiled Dance Aaron cut wood AM Plowed Pm  
 ground for head this morning. fine truly  
 10 This morning at 7 1/2 o'clock it pleased God to  
 release my dear Mother of her sufferings she  
 died calm & peaceful W. Cold. a very little snow  
 11 Friends in & out. I have very sore boil on my right  
 wrist. I am writing this on the 15<sup>th</sup> W. Clear Cool  
 12 Buried Dear Mother today a large Funeral Sermon  
 on 2<sup>nd</sup> Cor 5<sup>th</sup> C 1<sup>st</sup> & by B. J. Benney & J. Hower about 120  
 Friends here after service W. beautiful. fine October day  
 13 J. B. came. helped to finish picking winter Apples Aaron  
 Plowed Pm. W. fine Red M. Rohrer & wife & Mother's  
 Cousin Mrs Oberholzer, from Ohio were Pm. B. D. & B. C.  
 brought them. I my Boil very sore  
 14 Aaron Plowed I & boys brought 3 Pigs from W. H.  
 boys brought 300 tils & brought home grain <sup>Pm W. cold</sup>  
 Sunday 15 at home all day. nobody here John & girls  
 went to Meeting at Widemans. W. very Cold NW wind  
 16 Aaron finished plowing barley stubble AM wheeled  
 hen manure into garden Pm. W. pretty Cold. my Boil  
 17 Aaron Plowed at B. C. AM dug in garden Pm  
 I went to B. D. AM. to Mayers & J. D. I went  
 to ask them to help put up sheds for Horses  
 at Hebron W. pretty Cold wind clear  
 18 Aaron finished digging garden & began pulling turnip  
 I was at Hebron where they have began putting up  
 sheds I am going about 2 acre north of graveyard  
 for a yard. W. beautiful fine day M. Hower began  
 19 Cleaned some Peas this morning then I & Children <sup>German School</sup>  
 went to Meeting at Hebron Nancy kept house Remmon's  
 on by Red Rohrer & Drussel from Medina  
 Co Ohio Aaron pulled turnip Mr. Martin & wife, Poyden  
 & wife & B. D. & B. N. were here Pm. W. very fine  
 20 Took Ann Shirk to J. W. Widemans AM Cleaned  
 28 bags barley Pm. W. very fine clear
