Frost last night. Sunny day breezy, warmer to-day. We spread 6 loads manure No 2 corn land A.M. Willie chopped some. P.M. Willie rolled rest of hay field No 6 also new seeding No 3 & and new strip N.W. of No 6 bush also some in No 5 which I continued in evening. I plowed sod for corn No 2 P.M. long plow which would not clear

Tuesday

Fine sunny day breezy cool. We disked, cultivated, and put fertilizer on mangel land A.M. P.M. Willie finished rolling No 5 and I cultivated corn land. Mr. Cox over at night to see about hay I wrote a card to R. Hanna (for him) for hay. Mary walked down P.M. to stay down.

Wednesday

Windy, warmer cloudy mostly. rained a few drops P.M. We spread 6 loads manure on No 2 corn land A.M. P.M. I drilled up 23 drills and Willie plowed corn land, we sowed 19 drills mangels of the 23 I made using the Bob. Lindale seeder. Mary came up this A.M. she got meat shortbread 65cts wall paper Phillips 60cts crock 70 & 38cts she deposited church money and got marked cheque for \$280.00 for I. Bonville paid 1ct for stamp. # Receipts didn't come 2 for milk this morning. I took pack to Foods unless Bella bought an apron from a gypsy woman 75cts
