Wed Oct 4 clear and hot. Aunt Victoria and Smith called in this evening. I got a letter from Vic from Cleveland

Thu Oct 5th clear and pleasant. was over to see Sarah who is not much better

Fri Oct 6th clear I went over to Aunt Vic's to bid Anne Smith good by Sarah was over
