 Hamiltons Stopt at Hamiltons all night  
 ready to go to Cornwall in the Morning  
 1<sup>st</sup> St. Michael Michaelmas Day Went  
 Cornwall very high Wind South West  
 and a good Shower to put down the Dust

 Randolph crossed 6<sup>th</sup> Fine West Wind and North  
 cutting Board on the Roof of the Porch I  
 some Sticks for the upper stable cut the  
 tobacco peeling apples Cold nights 7<sup>th</sup>  
 fine Smoky Dull Rained some at the Floor  
 seeing stalls in the Horse Stable Seander  
 of Blackbirds Water Low Rained to night  
 Wind Rained some one of the Sues here fo  
 Butter seen a flock of Wild Geese go  
 South East Turned the double Stabe as it  
 fine in the cooking Stone today cold  
 work up some Turnips and put them in the  
 Phillip helped to put a Log on the stable  
 Leman came up Wednesday  
 Bohemian did not go into Lancaster
