21 little Bilkie came here last night went away this morning  
pretty hard frost last night Ad put up fence

22 Rev. Mr. Dunlop preached this morning Mr. Robinson at night

<sup>snow</sup> 23 very high winds last night & all day with a little snow  
Ad tried to draw some wood brock the Baby died nothing

24 put up part of the line fence between Capland & the pasture  
the wind is so strong yet that it blew some that we put  
up down we are trying to keep our sheep out of Capland

25 Ad drew some wood got J. Bradleys bobblys wood

26 heavy rain & wind most of the day Ad cut some

27 Ad went to Robert Johnsons & got 11.00 lb of hay  
brought it home 14 dollars per tier  
on the waggon Robert White got our boning meat  
the ground is very hard frozen

28 I spoiled & quilted Ad put the road fence first  
ditch to the corner north

29 Rev. Mr. Robinson preached this morning & Rev. J.  
Mr. Dunlop in the afternoon

30 Ad drew rails from the north field center  
fence to make a center fence in the field  
below the Barn

31 Ad cut some wood at the house
