August 13 continued Saturday Forward

 cleaned grain etc. Paid Jim and Doug \$2.00  
 Willie down town at night got at Sticks  
 & collars <sup>25</sup> shoe black <sup>25</sup>

Fine sunny day. Mr McVinn  
 preached in A.M. from 8th commandment  
 Thou shalt not steal and in evening  
 from Zechariah 11. 9. 13. 14 Coll Messins <sup>\$1.50</sup>

Fine sunny day warm in P.M.  
 looked like rain some thunder in evening  
 Doug and Jim up all day hoeing  
 mangols We put Bordeaux mixture  
 also Paris green in it on potatoes in  
 Morning I scuffled mangols and  
 turnips and harrowed stump field  
 Willie got at Ferts yeast cake 25

16 Tuesday

Thunder lightning and heavy rain last night  
 again dark clouds and thunder all day  
 some rain in P.M. We hauled clay to road in  
 A.M. and in P.M. Willie took down 10 bags pig chips  
 got both shod at Samplins <sup>20</sup> harness mended etc M. & D. 80 cts  
 at Armstrongs wheel Gerns <sup>25</sup> cts. I hoed mangols in P.M.  
 We went up to see cattle at night
