& I picked them dry. after dinner I made an apple ^{cake} sauce
very cold day & wind still blowing

Friday 24. I cleaned the floor blacked the stove swept
the front room & Marguerite dusted & I made whole cookies
Paul walked to Chippawa & took the 3 1/2 of butter that I had
marked for Tuesday. I am killed 25. bread 15. cup & saucer 25
the cheese 10 2 the candy 10 one for Marjorie & one for Marguerite
I stuffed the chicken & roasted it made dressing
for the goose. Paul went after Marjorie. Will & Arthur on
Donnell brought the meat.

'Christmas' 25 wind east snowy at times & dull Bernhard
Arrived before dinner he stayed until after tea & Paul
took him to Grates. the roast goose was fine but I did
not enjoy the day. John Mc Gredie came home last night
Sun 26. Hattie went to the Montrose Sunday school & gave
a beautiful address. Hattie went to the break then they came
here for tea we sent for them Paul went to Ed Wells for beer
Mon 27. cold day. Will & John Reisinger went over to the
hall. Stanley took a load to Keller took Marguerite with
them on the big sleigh. Hattie rode over with them she
was going back to Beecher. Paul went to the ice house
this afternoon I churned & worked the butter & made pies
Frank Reisinger brought the beef 11 1/4 1/4 lb a 6 1/2
came in 27. 77. paid \$4.00 had time to stew on supper

bitter cold day 10 below zero this morning. had a roast of beef

Thur 30. snowing it keeps cold yet. terribly cold Marjorie
made the plum pudding for dinner Paul had her at night
Arthur to Fred getting out ice beautiful sunshine but very
Friday 31 The youngsters went to Montagues for dinner Stanley
brought them home snow up to their knees in places & snowing
hard when they went. Arthur to Mc Gredie's Fred killed their
lids then in the afternoon

January 1910

Jan 1. Arthur went to Chippawa with the beef to Kaumgar
took 2 lb butter for us got 1 lb tea 31. 25 granulated sugar
& 1 lb soda. turned in rain & the snow is nearly gone
I churned for our selves & made apple pies we had mince
& we had beef fried for supper

Sun 2. cold wind but much on places not much snow
left. only 9 in church. the minister went with Tom Mc Gredie
Hattie over in the evening

Tue 3. Will went with Reisinger boys to the town hall
Arthur went to vote then to Chippawa got his black horse
shod. Miss Andrew came back to her school but did
not teach the 8 Mrs Reeb, Mrs Harvey Well & Mrs Fred Well
prepared the lobby at the school house the wind started to
blow from the west & it snowed & drifted it turned out
a wild night not so cold as blustering high wind
the cows were all covered with snow when Marjorie went out
to give the horse her feed she had a big time fixing the door
