@ 9.35 = \$72.46. Recd Payment.
went out to church at night.
heavy rain. come home.
- May 18 Wednesday. doing chores. sprouting
potatoes in cellar. windy & damp after
the rain. wrote letter to H.E.P.
Recd balance on pigs \$4.22. & settled
with F.W.M. for chopping. 44¢.
- May 19 Thursday. doing chores. went to
mill & got 2½ bushel seed corn.
F.W.M. took oats to get chopped.
cultivating on hoe crop ground.
- May 20 Friday. King Edward VII buried.
rain this afternoon. Working on
hoe crop ground. in fore noon.
F.W.M. sawed ear corn. on east side
of field. Father had team away to
Pauses mill. to get frames for home.
- May 21 Saturday. doing chores. took down
old picket fence. & took out post.
F.W.M. working in garden & orchard.
Sent Letter to H.E.P. very warm.
- May 22 Sunday. doing chores. Went to church
in morning. with Mother cloudy &
east wind. went up to junction in
P.M. & took picture. also went to
church at night. Rev Mr. Fisher
preached. Memorial sermon.
