22 bus Oats to Cedar Grove Mills P.M. W. mild <sup>though</sup>  
18 Joe drew 7 long logs to D.M. I went to J.D. I.A.M.  
brought home Chop P.M. W. very cold strong north wind  
Sunday 19 at home. John & girls went to meeting at  
Cedar Grove A.B. & C.B. were here & B.D. this evening  
20 Joe drew logs A.M. I & little boys cut old Cedar Peas  
beam in two it is white Oak. Joe helped P.M. & we  
cut the two bottom timbers they are Black Ash  
W. strong wind from east A.M. began to snow heavy  
about noon. snowed all P.M. snowing yet  
21 Joe drew logs I drew 2 Cedar Peas logs A.M.  
little John drew 2 P.M. I Mayes were here P.M.  
22 Joe drew logs <sup>slightly pretty good</sup> I drew last 3 Cedar Peas logs & 1  
P.M. out of old bush. W. fine, thawing, some  
23 Joe drew logs, we started to go to J.B. met them  
up the townline going to C.B. then I & boys took  
about 10 bus of snow out of Hebron Meeting  
house garnet, then J.B. came P.M. hitched up  
our mare Colt Copy. she went very well  
W. fine warm. snow going fast  
24 went to Markham & to Finlans Joe went to witness  
Beas's funeral W. fine warm. Clear, wind from east P.M.  
25 Chord. Joe went to Beas's W. soft snow from east last  
night & A.M. turned to rain P.M. mild & thawing  
Sunday 26 I & Nancy & children except John & Susanna

went to meeting at Hebron <sup>Monday</sup> <sup>at 10</sup> by the I Hovers <sup>arrived</sup>  
on St Mark & C by B.C. P.M. I Hovers & wife were here P.M.  
W. Foggy & damp. soft, snowy & drizzly nearly all day  
People all came to meeting with sleigs  
27 I & B.C. hitched up our Colt A.M. Nancy B. John  
came to exchange 20 bus spring wheat for seed A.M.  
I went to shed meeting at Hebron. Concluded to  
build shed facing the road. W. fine Clear  
Jacob Russor's were here this evening Joe drew  
28 I helped B.C. kill 4 Pigs A.M. Joe drew <sup>logs</sup>  
we fixed place in old barn for sheep P.M.  
W. fine A.M. heavy snow from east P.M.  
29 I went to Markham A.M. hired Aaron Stevenson  
@ \$12.00 per month & his washing for a term of  
& months done nothing P.M. Joe was at Beas's  
he is leaving here to work for Beas's family  
W. very heavy snow fall last night snow about  
a foot deep on the level. drifted some  
30 I went to McDykes A.M. to see about getting out with  
sawlogs found snow too deep A.M. I & John drove  
to Sparta with Colt P.M. Joe drew a few logs that  
were near the road. W. mild Clear  
31 found a new box on heavy Bobs & filled bags  
with Potatoes A.M. Joe started for Toronto with  
30 bags P.M. I & little boys drove to Whitvale  
with Colt P.M. W. fine & warm thawing a little
