- 1 Saturday I plowed all day
- 2 Sunday we went to church at 10 o'clock
- 3 Monday raining till 10 o'clock I plowed only I did this forenoon in the afternoon
- 4 Tuesday we went to the society
- 4 Thursday I plowed for Mitchel all day
- 5 Friday sharrow helped me to clean a load of barley
- 6 Saturday I went to crows with a load of barley sold for \$1.29 cents 22 hundred 17 pounds
- 7 Sunday we went to here Mr forest
- 8 Monday Mr Trembly and I cleaned a load of barley in the afternoon Mary and me dug potatoes
- 9 Tuesday we went to the picnic
- 10 Wednesday dug potatoes Mary and me to day
- 11 Thursday I went to Chatham with a load of barley sold for \$1.23 cents I had 22 hundred and 66
- 12 Friday Mitchel and Mary and I finished digging my potatoes
- 13 Saturday it is raining and snowing to day
- 14 Sunday we went to here Mr King
- 15 Monday I fixed the hog pen
- 16 Tuesday I tied corn straw and drewed one load of corn
- 17 Wednesday I husked a little and drewed a load and a half of corn
- 18 Thursday I took the last of my barley out to Mr Crow ~~at~~ price \$1.22 per hundred I had twelve hundred and sixty pounds
- 19 Friday I logged at home
- 20 Saturday I tied corn straw all day
- 21 Sunday went to here Mr forest
