Willie finished plowing turf land that we was at a.m. I worked in garden etc. P.M. we hauled some stones large ones off green crop land and Willie picked Wm Clark off a.m. got eggs 45 etc. Willie down at night paid Russell 5's balance on separator got 2 lbs lunch and a c/c Mr Goss on at night	45	55
16	Wednesday	Fine sunny warm day. We got land ready and drilled and sowed 52 more drill turneps to-day. Mr W. Fudge came with John Clark and castrated colt Peter at noon. We had quite a time with him. They got dinner here.
