17th Shot an Owl 18th Raining Francis here
left his canoe left hay seed 19th John Nine here
let him have Francis canoe 20th John & Bought an
egg 15 cents 1 lb of Butter 25 So Luckett and Brother
here & crushed the Manure Brought 1 1/2 Dg of Herring
and a Basket of Apples and a Viol putting the
ashes out of the Barrel into a Big Box and West
Wind 21st On this Day of the Month D. Master
Departed 1846 Freezing at night & Wind Fine Cool
put the Dars in the cellar a Day or 2 ago Keeping in
the Horse but cattle out Feeding Lots of Rawn
Randolph and Leander to Christies Randolph
crossed to Post Office 3 Boats went up and 3 went down
Day 22nd not Well & Wind 23rd & Wind
not very well put some of the Preserves in
the cellar and Bottles out of the Milk house
24th & Wind Freezing some a Propellar
went up Began to snow to night take
in irons and lifting up things scattered on the ground
