Fine day sunny clouded over and rained in evening. Jim Fernal up all day. We hoed turnips in a.m. Willie put Paris green mixture on potatoes with watering can. In P.M. we hauled in 5 loads barley Jim built loads I helped in snow and worked at fence around new orchard when they were loading

Heavy rain last night. cloudy and sunny to-day. Willie took load straw over to Scharis in a.m. and me to Quinns in P.M. got pig feed at Wilsons in aft 55<sup>0</sup> lbs black dust 375 lbs corn bag bran I worked at orchard fence hoed 4 rows turnips etc. Willie down town at night got spring for binder from Chapman 10cts

Saturday

Fine day cloudy morning cleared off sunny. I hoed 4 rows turnips in morning then we cut outs in No 1 they are badly down in places cut some one away at bottom. after tea we brought in rest of barley 2 loads

Sunday

Fine day sunny. Wm Geric preached in a.m. from I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ etc. and in evening from Isaiah 40:8.

Monday.

Fine sunny day not so warm. I scuffed rape No 7 in a.m. Willie finished cutting No 1 W I stooked in P.M.
