Some Common Knee Affections—No. 5.

The physical signs of a tuberculous knee, whether in the child or adult, are usually sufficiently pronounced to enable one to arrive at a proper conclusion without delay; but there are instances, especially when the family history is tuberculous, that are extremely puzzling. The loss of contour, the general thickening, the bony enlargement, the reflex spasm and the extreme chronicity, are usually quite enough for a diagnosis.—Hunter; Mass. Med. Journ.
