

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July 1903 fair

We had quite a shower last night and could not work at wheat today so John scuffled & Father, Geo & I hoed turnips all day.

Friday 31<sup>st</sup> fine

We started about 9 am  
11 & hauled .11 loads wheat  
& hoed turnips till 9 am.

Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> Aug 1903 fine

John went to Byr's thrashing &  
Father Geo & I hauled wheat  
7<sup>1/2</sup> loads & 1 load raskings  
3 & 3 loads barley  
Mary & children went to  
Siemie

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> fine

Father Mary & I went to  
Church. Children & I to S.S.  
Mother & I in evening  
heard Dr Willoughby both  
times.

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> fine

We finished hauling barley  
5 loads John scuffled turnips  
& Father & Geo hoed.

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> wet

We skinned and put  
dip on lambs. and  
John went to Harvey's thrashing  
in afternoon, we weaned  
lambs today

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> fair but dull

John plowed in morning Geo  
hoed turnips all day  
& Chae & Father & I went  
to town bgt shoes \$3<sup>00</sup> &  
ordered a pair for myself  
pd. Goldies ac. \$19<sup>35</sup>  
pd. for Geo at Seroggie's \$1<sup>14</sup>  
paid \$1<sup>25</sup> to Mr walk & this  
ordered 1/2 ton bran & 10 bu corn
