Mon May 21. Fine and moderately warm, we washed. Annie went to Mrs Brealey here in the evening. Morley helped cut grass. Sizzies and shut house up. Auntie and I at Grave yard eve.

Tue May 22. Fine day. Auntie and I in Toronto, changed light coat  $\frac{1}{15}$  for black at 22.50. Mrs Reaman died. Willies called.

Wed May 23. Fine and warmer, we called at Mr Reamans. Auntie Dr.

Thur May 24. Victoria Day. I went to Mrs Reamans funeral. Mary here for a while. put in more peas. at Grave yard, an ideal day. No fire in heater.

Fri May 25. Fine quite warm going without a coat. Meta Jackson and Mrs Will Orr called. Varnished dining room.

Sat May 26. Very warm. Setting out, we called at Mrs Parkinsons. F. Cox brought small basket of berries.
