Willie took load turnips down to Scheris A.M. a track hanger broke in root house and litter carrier full of turnips fell down and twisted tracks. I got it straightened and put up again. Willie brought Mary up he took another load turnips down P.M. and brought up barrel of gasoline from CPR station B. A. Dick also the chopped oats got yesterday from mill. Paid Lou Sargent for them \$23.85 cheque J.B. Mary got note paper 15 cts, at Russells goods 39 cts (on 25th) she also took 2 doz eggs to Russells 76 cts got goods \$1.12

Mary got parcel at Russells on dc Jack calved yesterday red calf also 2 sheep had 2 lambs each one of the lambs died to-day.
